ANY Pets who come in our gate needs to be register at the office per Board of Health--

“3701-26-04 Responsibilities of the licensee. (H) The licensee of a campground shall properly maintain the campground, buildings, sites and facilities in a clean and sanitary manner and as follows:

(8) Require the registration of all pets that are permitted within the campground prior to entry; and

(9) Promptly report to the health commissioner of the health district where the campground is located cases of either domestic or wild animal bites inflicted upon any person in the campground area.”

A \$55 a month fine will be charged lot owners until this is done.

This also includes visiting dogs. Per State of Ohio all dogs on a leash or in their yard. You are responsible for your pets.
