



POOL RULES

1. Pool privileges extended to Kamp-A-Lott members and their guests. Past due assessments will result in loss of pool privileges for member and their guests.
2. All persons must enter the pool through the main entrance to the pool.
3. Children under 10 must be accompanied at all times by an adult.
4. All persons in pool area must wear Kamp-A-Lott pool tag with lot number visible.
5. Swim diapers are required for all children who are not toilet trained.
6. Diaper changing on or around the pool concrete is prohibited.
7. Please notify a lifeguard immediately if your child has an accident in the water or on the pool concrete. Do not try to clean it up yourself.
8. Do not bring sick children to the pool until they are symptom-free for at least 24 hours.
9. Bathing suits must be worn in the pool. Jeans, shorts, under garments, thong suits, or any sort of non-swimming apparel is not permitted. T-shirts that are not offensive may be worn over swimsuits. Kamp-A-Lott Park Manager or Pool Manager reserves the right to deem what is appropriate and persons wearing inappropriate suits will be asked to change and/or leave the premises.
10. Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children. Supervise your swimmers at all times and know where they are while inside the facility. The primary responsibility of pool lifeguards is to enforce pool rules and respond to emergencies, not to babysit.
11. The use of pool noodles and flotation devices for children is permitted.
12. Any crowded or unsafe conditions may result in the pool capacity being restricted.
13. Persons should not talk to on-duty lifeguards except in case of emergency.
14. Children may be asked to demonstrate adequate swimming ability to be able to swim in the deep end.
15. There shall be no running, dunking, towel snapping, horseplay, pushing, throwing of litter or any other activity deemed dangerous or inappropriate by the lifeguards or management.
16. Profanity or abusive language will not be tolerated.
17. Smoking and vaping are prohibited.
18. There shall be no destruction of property.
19. Persons with open wounds, wearing band aids, stitches or skin infections are not allowed in the pool.
20. Pets are not allowed in the pool, unless the animal is a guide dog as permitted by law.
21. Alcohol and glassware are prohibited.
22. Persons suspected to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be denied entry or required to leave the premises.
23. Violations of pool rules may result in warning, temporary suspension of pool privileges or expulsion.
