Kamp-A-Lott Board Summary November 12th

Dave Graham has been able to procure a used, one year old double air conditioner for the lodge. New Owner Procedures and forms for the office file have been developed. New Contact update forms will soon be sent out for owners to return to the office. (Thank you in advance!)KAL Received 5 loads of asphalt millings and should get 3 more – this will be used next summer for road improvements. Currently disputing the October Republic Trash removal bill due to an outrageous increase for the sludge removal rate and plus rates increased across the board in August. No prior notification was given for the price increases. Rules and Regulations committee met November 9th continuing edits and discussion. Steve Moore and Scott Price volunteered to join committee to continue discussions. The Board has received a quote for a new barrier gate for the addition of an exit only gate at KAL entrance. This would allow for an entrance and an exit gate to help with traffic, and do away with the swing gate. If approved, the installation will be completed by Frank. When an owner receives a violation letter, they will now be responsible for the postage required. The board approved that a performing band will now receive one free camping lot with their contract. The lot assessment late fee penalty was discussed. Increased percentage or deciding on a flat rate was tabled until next month. Procedures for handling late assessments will be created. The Social Committee has asked that the lodge restrooms be cleaned 1X weekly. Also discussed improvements needed with ceilings in the lodge restrooms and kitchen. Beth Moore volunteered to mow the lawn at the pool. She has done this in the past but had to stop due to medical issues. She has recovered and is eager to begin again this volunteer action. There was discussion regarding how to deter folks from living at KAL off season, possibly rising electric rates during off season. The Board will investigate the necessity of plowing roads during off season due to the cost of fuel.
